**Stubbington Study Centre Residential Week for Years 3 and 4
Monday 1st to Wednesday 3rd July 2024**

We are delighted to offer children in Years 3 and 4 the opportunity to attend a residential visit to Stubbington Study Centre from Monday 1st to Wednesday 3rd July 2024. **This is a 3 day and 2 night stay.**

At Springwood, we believe all children have the right and should be encouraged to develop the many skills required to be successful in adulthood. These include the ability to work both as an integral member of a team and independently. Learning to respect and support each other in a range of ways can help all children succeed when faced with new challenges both in and outside of school.

Stubbington Study Centre is a fantastic location which offers many opportunities for children to embrace challenge and acquire new skills through adventurous activities. The children also learn about the local environment, the animals and plants found within the grounds and the importance of being responsible. They also begin to learn how to organise themselves. All the activities have been fully vetted and approved by Hampshire County Council to make sure they are as safe as possible and all staff are fully qualified to lead the activities. The children will be sleep indoors in dormitories. The visit will take place on the understanding that all parents participating are prepared to meet the cost involved of **£170 per pupil**. This includes the cost of the accommodation, all activities, and food and travel costs.

We know this time of year is expensive and that money is having to go further so this year so we wanted to give you as much time as possible to pay the **non-refundable deposit of £50** through Sco-Pay. This can be done in **instalments or as a one off payment** but the deposit **must be received by 5pm on Monday 5th February 2024.**

There are limited places and these will be given on a first come first served basis. As previously stated, the initial deposit of £50 is a non-refundable. Furthermore, the full balance could be incurred if you decide not to send your child after the 6th May 2024 payment deadline, as the centre do not refund money.
