## Hanukkah – (concept symbol) Step 2 - Contextualise

Learning objective

To be able to accurately describe how and why Jewish people celebrate Hanukkah.

Key question – What is the meaning of the Hanukkah lights for Jews?

The children acted out the story 'The Miracle of the Oil'.



The oil burned for 8 days instead of 1!

They made the temple dirty so the Jews had to clean it before they could use it again.

The Maccabees fought against the Greek King Antiochus.

The Jewish people thought pigs were unclean and the Greeks put them in the temple!

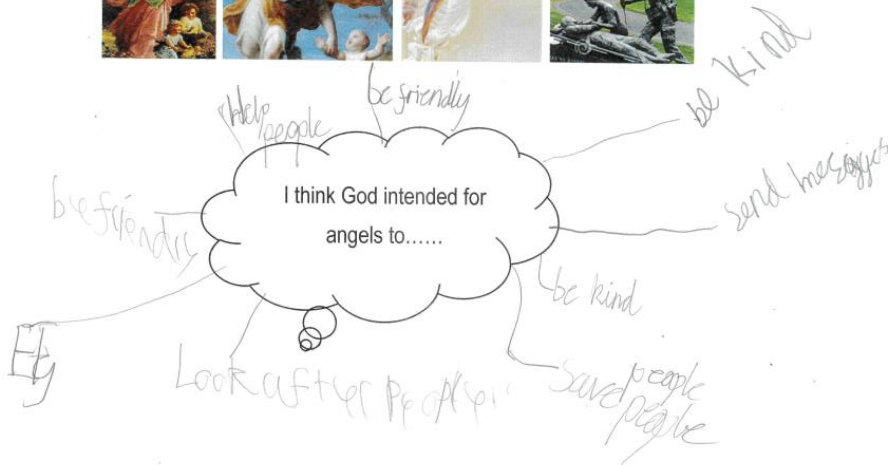
The Greek King didn't want the Jews to worship their God – he wanted them to worship the Greek Gods instead.

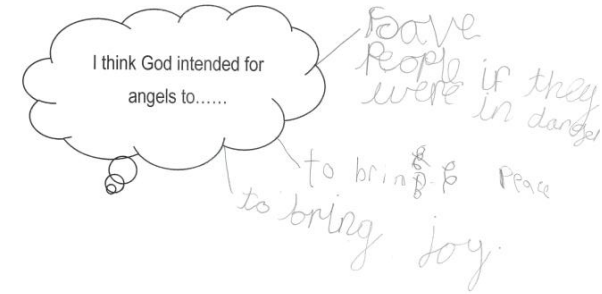

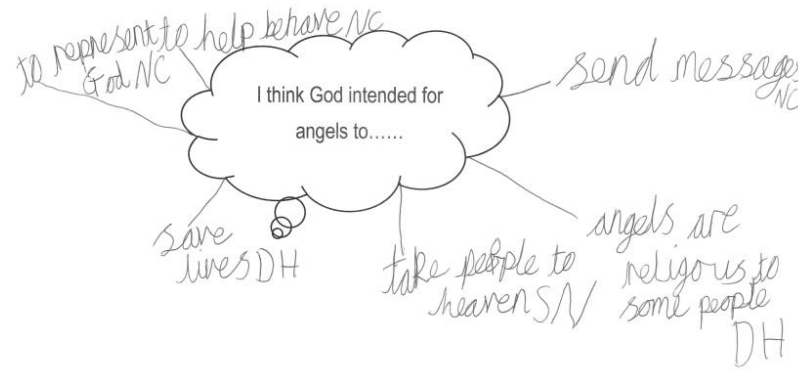

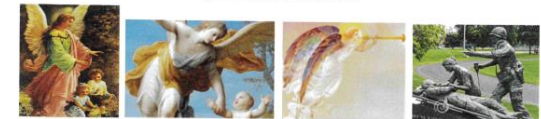

Dear Diary,

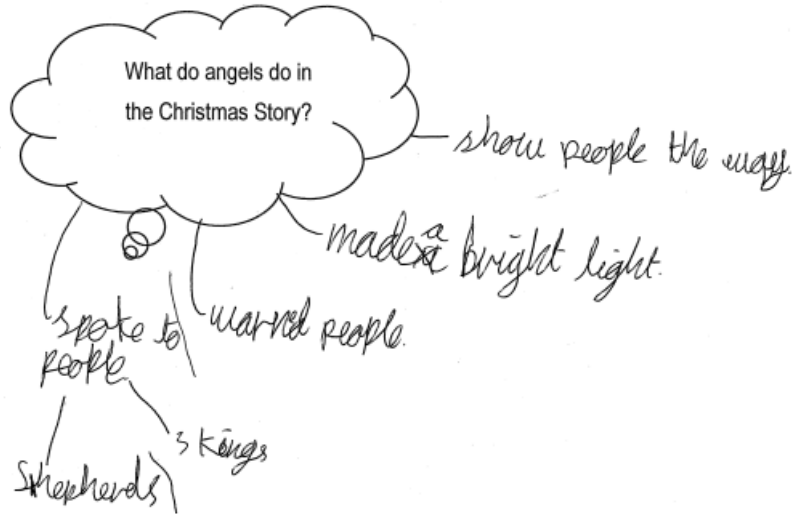
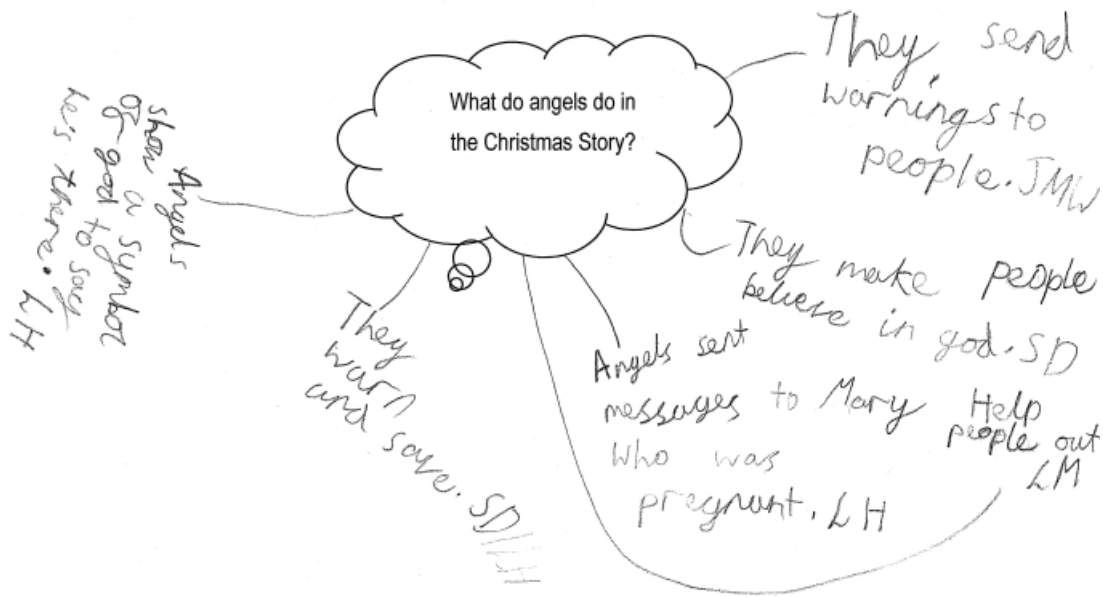
